

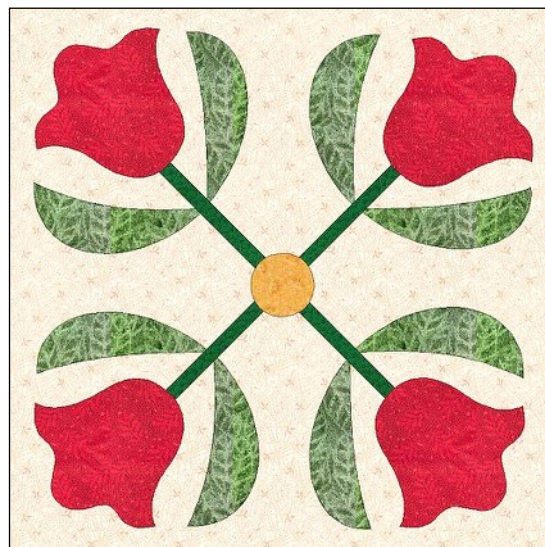
Carolina Tulip

When printing the templates, ensure that paper size is set to A4, and scale to 100%

This block appears to come from the Appalachian region of the USA, between the years of 1850 - 1890.

Although the origin is not known, it exhibits strong characteristics of mid-19th century appliqué.



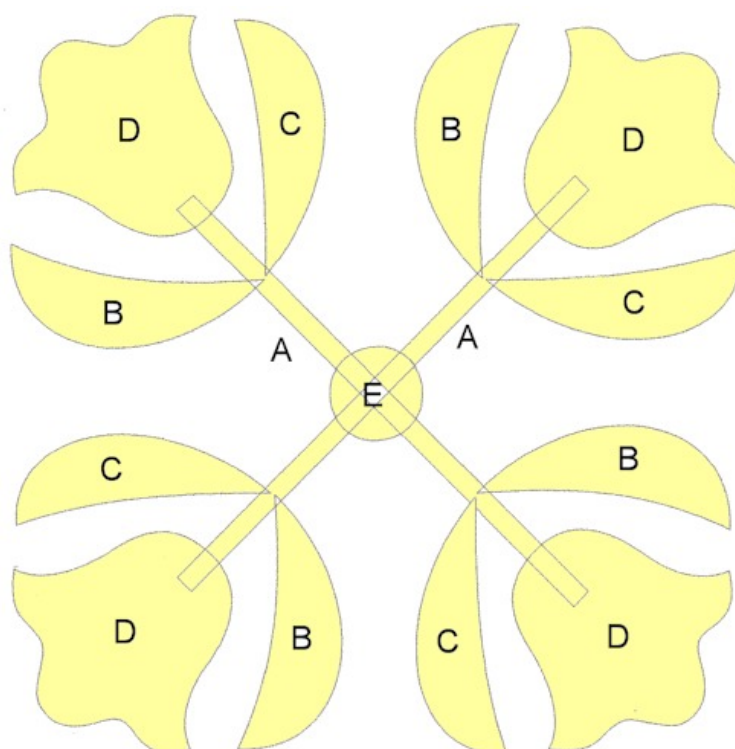
Cutting Instructions

Cut out the 5 templates.

1. Cut out a 13 inch square in Fabric 1.
2. Cut out 4 of template A in fabric 2.
3. Cut out 4 of template B in Fabric 3.
4. Cut out 4 of template C in Fabric 3.
5. Cut out 4 of template D in Fabric 4.
6. Cut out 1 of template E in Fabric 5.

Fabric

Fabric 1 - Cream
Fabric 2 - Dark Green
Fabric 3 - Light Green
Fabric 4 - Red
Fabric 5 - Yellow.



Assembly Instructions

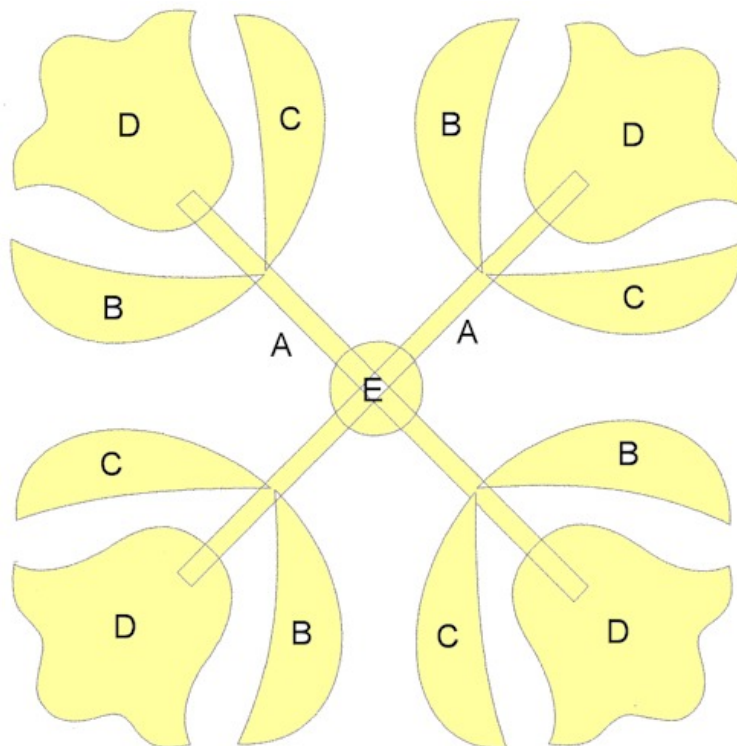
Using the diagram as a guide, the pieces will be appliquéd on in the following order.

The 13 inch square is the background for the tulips.

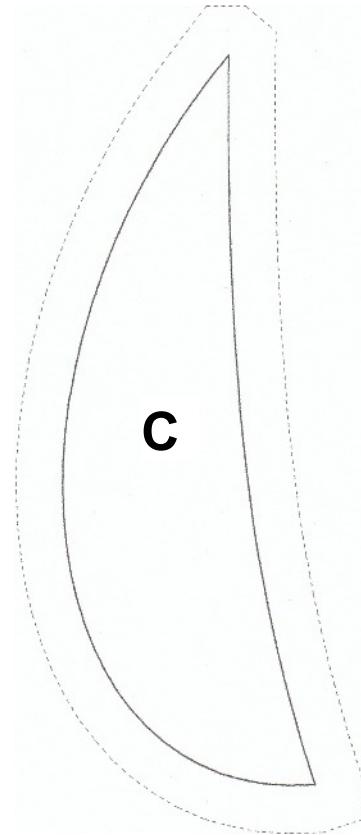
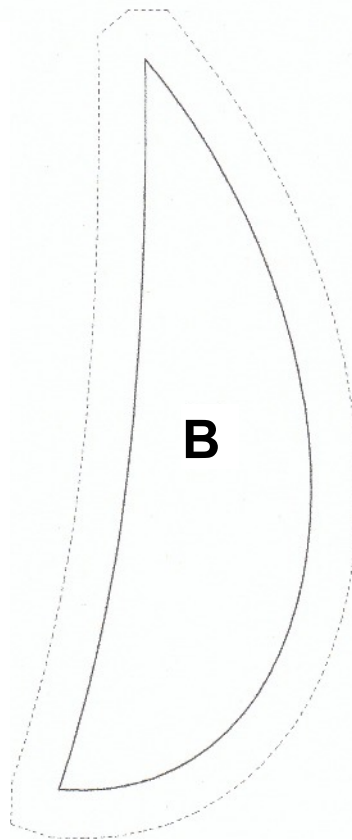
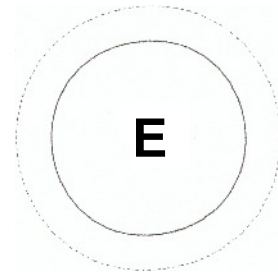
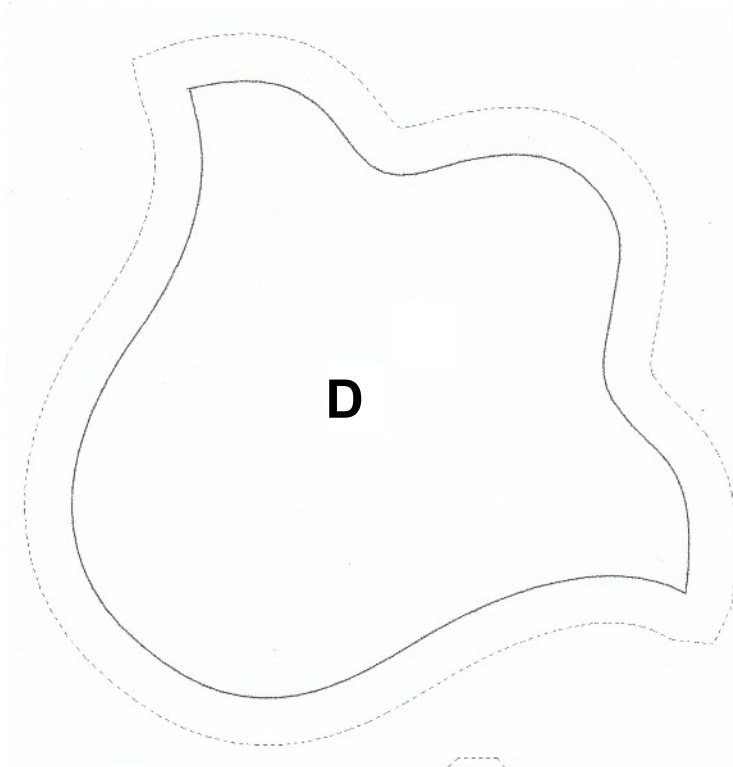
1. The 4 of Template A in Fabric 2.
2. The 4 of template B in Fabric 3.
3. The 4 of template C in Fabric 3.
4. The 4 of template D in fabric 4.
5. Lastly the one template E in Fabric 5.

I am leaving the method of appliqué to your own choice. However it might be advisable to draw the diagonals on to the square .This will give you the centre and guide lines for positioning the pieces.

Once you have sewn on all pieces trim the finished square to $12\frac{1}{2}$ inches.

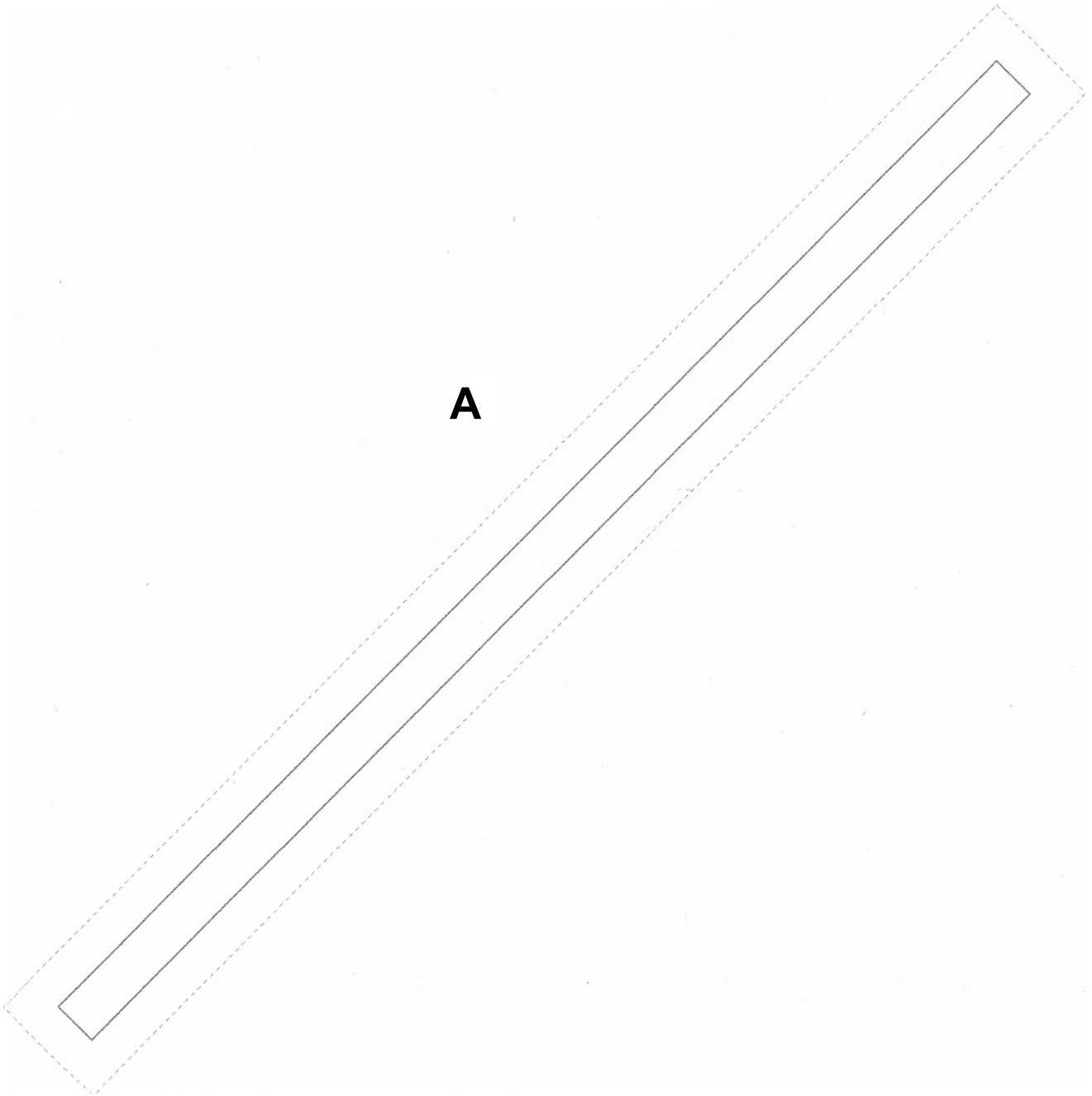


This template should be printed at 100% scale,
